

Gov't launches first phase of Puerto Rico Site Selection Map

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SAN JUAN – Economic Development Secretary Manuel Laboy and Planning Board President María del Carmen Gordillo announced Thursday the first phase of the Puerto Rico Site Selection Map, which includes an inventory of government-owned structures, facilities and lots.

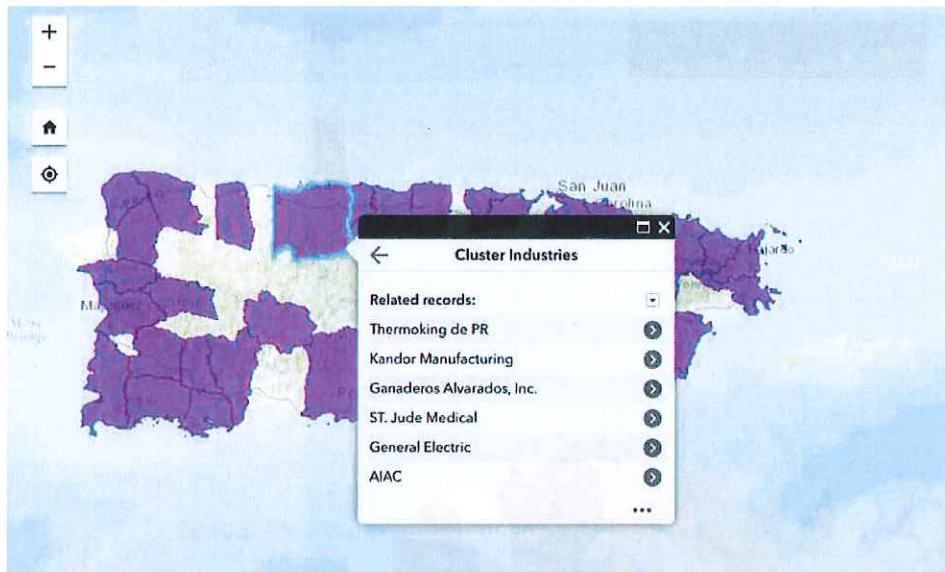
“We have to understand that we are competing with the world. This tool allows that, in one place, an entrepreneur or investor can, as an initial step, have all the information they need interactively to accelerate the process of establishing their business or expand the business they already have in Puerto Rico,” Laboy said at the press conference.

The map initially includes 2,000 government locales that are available and in use, belonging to the Puerto Rico Industrial Development Co., Land Authority, Trade & Export Co., Tourism Co. and the former Roosevelt Roads Naval Station in Ceiba.

For the second phase, it is expected to include all properties such as those belonging to the Department of Education as well as the public corporations.



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
