FTA Section 5307 – Urbanized Area Formula Program**

The Municipality of Arroyo, as a recipient of federal financial assistance under the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307 Urbanized Area Formula Program, hereby solicits sealed proposals from qualified firms to provide Preliminary and Final Engineering Design Services and Comprehensive Environmental Services for the proposed Intermodal Railway Transportation System Project.

The purpose of this solicitation is to retain a qualified professional firm with demonstrated experience in federally funded transit infrastructure projects to:

- Prepare the preliminary and final engineering design of the proposed Intermodal Railway Transportation System Project; and
- Develop all required environmental studies, technical evaluations, and documentation necessary to ensure full compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and other applicable federal environmental statutes and executive orders.

The selected consultant shall provide professional services sufficient to support the advancement of the project through environmental clearance and readiness for future capital implementation phases under FTA oversight. Firms submitting proposals must: demonstrate documented experience in FTA-funded transit capital projects, demonstrate capacity to comply with federal procurement and grant requirements, have an active Unique Entity Identifier (UEI), maintain active registration in SAM.gov at the time of proposal submission and demonstrate compliance with applicable civil rights and nondiscrimination requirements. Failure to meet mandatory eligibility requirements may result in the proposal being deemed non-responsive pursuant to federal procurement standards.

Interested firms may obtain the complete RFP documents, technical specifications, and submission instructions at the Municipal Secretary's Office, Morse Street #64, First Floor, Arroyo, Puerto Rico, or electronically by contacting the Auction Board via email at juntadesubasta@yahoo.com from the date of publication of this notice until March 16, 2026. Firms requesting the documents electronically are responsible for providing complete contact information to ensure receipt of any addenda issued during the solicitation period. The answers to questions submitted within this timeframe will be answered on or before April 3, 2026.

Proposals must be submitted in: One (1) original, One (1) copy, and One (1) digital copy (USB in PDF format), no later than April 17, 2026 until 10:00 a.m., at the Municipal Secretary's Office located at City Hall, First Floor, Morse Street #64, Arroyo, Puerto Rico. Late submissions shall not be considered.

This solicitation is issued in accordance with the procurement standards of 2 CFR §§200.317–200.327, requiring full and open competition. The Municipality reserves the right to: request clarifications or additional information; conduct discussions as permitted under federal procurement standards; request Best and Final Offers (BAFO), if deemed necessary; reject any or all proposals; cancel or reissue this solicitation; modify the scope consistent with funding availability and regulatory approvals. Nothing in this solicitation shall obligate the Municipality to award a contract.

The Municipality of Arroyo complies with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and all related nondiscrimination statutes and regulations. The participation of bidders certified as "Disadvantaged Business Enterprise" (DBE) or the subcontracting of said organizations and/or companies is encouraged.
